The Interactive Metronome® (IM) is a new computer-based program and training tool for timing, planning, and sequencing. The IM uses spatially and tonally changing sounds to help a user correct temporal errors in the rhythmicity of their movements. Increasing evidence suggests that motor planning and sequencing, rhythmicity and timing are relevant to attentional, social, and learning problems. The IM focuses on building foundations to support motor regulation and the ability to focus and attend.

- Attention
- Motor Planning
- Speech and Language
- Learning Disabilities
- Timing and Sequencing
